Peace lilies are commonly called "White Sails" after their resemblance to white flags gushing out as a sign of peace. There is one species within the genus *Spathiphyllum* of the family Araceae. Despite what the name suggests, peace lilies are not really lilies, but rather a perennial. Meaning they live for over two years and have the potential to flourish more than once in their lives. This makes them a perfect and beautiful addition to the home. These pretty plants add a touch of colour and elegance to any room. The colored flowers and leaves are a good indication that something is wrong with your peace lily and that it is unhappy. Adequate Living Conditions The number one cause of stress is inadequate living conditions it thinking too little light or the wrong amount of irrigation. Try moving the plant to another part of the room, in dim sunlight and away from sketches. Make sure the soil is not too wet or that your plant is kneading from dehydration. If you've done the basics and your lily is still looking a bit malicious, try changing the nutrient content in the soil. But be warned, not needing repotting or overly generous fertilizer additions can do more harm than good. Of course, if you're doing everything right and you still have brown flowers then it might just be old age. The flowers of the peace lily have a lifespan that can last between a week and a month. The average life of those beautiful white blooms lasting only 10 days. The discoloration of the flower can begin by returning to a shade of green. This is then followed by a brown coloring of peace lily flowers before turning black. The length of flowering can be extended by taking good care of your plant. Also beheading your peace lily will encourage even more flowers to grow in the future. To properly decapitate your peace lily, use pruning shears to cut the flower leg as close to the plant as possible. Provide as much space as possible for another flower stalk to grow in its place. It is perfectly natural for your old flowers, along with old leaves, to turn brown and die. However, if your peace lily flowers are spinning before their time, this could be a cry of help from your small plant. Unfortunately, there is no quick solution for browning flowers. The best way to solve the blooms unexpectedly is to cut them. The decapitation to the plant is the best way to free some room in the hope that your little lily will prove Every luck, and the right care, your lily could be sprouting beautiful flowers within a month. Other health problems it "What is wrong? There are other common health problems for peace lilies that are easily solved. No flower the peace lilies will not flow if they are not in optimal conditions. If your peace lily is not florinding, it's probably not getting enough sunlight. The lack of sufficient light is the main cause of the reduced flowering in Peace Lilies. Simply move your loved plant in dried light will solve this problem and your Lily will be bloom in a very short time! Yellow / red leaves The leaves can turn brown with the age. It is perfectly normal that the larger leaves change color and start dying, just like the one you see in older flowers. If younger leaves are changing color, then it could be an overwatering sign. Peace lilies benefit from more irregular watering than watering to a program. You should only water peace Lily when the surface soil feels dry to the touch. The dye leaves can be built to the center of the plant. Leaf edges that turn brown if your poor peace lily is turning a little brown around the edges, it could be a bit burning! The peace lilies suffer from direct sunlight and require a moist environment. If you notice the edges of the Brunette leaves, remove the lily from direct light. Or spray with a fine fog or place the pot in a cough of wet gravel to increase the moisture around your plant. Control of pests and powders to keep your peace lily healthy and happy, it is recommended to regularly clean the leaves with a damp cloth to remove dust and parasites like mites or mushrooms. The added advantage of keeping your clean plant is that the removal of dust should help you feel better too. The fungal spores can also grow on the moist soil, to prevent this from drying the ground to dry and not flood the vase regularly. If the mushroom on the ground's surface of your Lily of Peace is a recurring problem, consider giving your peace Lily fresh land when the next repot or spray with a recommended or pesticide fungicide. Replanting more than once a year is not recommended and could stress your plant, damaging its flower production and health. Proparepeace Lilies can be easily propagated by dividing a larger plant in two or older. The propagation in peace lilies works because plants are made up of growing foliage beams Directly from the ground, rather than a single stem. To divide a lily of peace, it is necessary to overturn the current pot from its side and grasp the plant firmly, then gently swipe the plant from the pot. Be careful not to pull the plant, otherwise you risk damaging it. Once your peace lily will be free from the planter, notice where the stems are connected to the roots. You can divide the plant so as to ensure that both new plants have one Good dose of a connected radical apparatus. If you can see a way to divide it more than two, then you can do it easily. Where you would like to separate the plants, hold the plant on each side. If you have difficulty separating them and the roots are intertwined, you can take a knife or scissors and cut the ball to half.
