How to use kms activator for office 2010

Office 2010 KMS activation key facts Many admins who still haven't upgraded to Vista or Windows 7 will first have to deal with volume activation when they deploy Office 2010. Microsoft's documentation about Office 2010 volume activation is quite comprehensive. Today, I will summarize the key facts about Office 2010 KMS activation. In my next post, I will cover MAK activation, and in the last post of this series I will compare Office 2010 KMS and MAK activation. Office 2010 KMS activation key facts ^KMS, which stands for Key Management Service Host, is software for Windows that works as a proxy for Windows Vista, Windows 7, and Office 2010 activation. Office 2010 volume editions are delivered with the KMS client, which doesn't have to be installed. KMS clients will find the KMS host automatically through DNS. When an end user starts Office 2010 (no admin privileges required), the KMS client will contact the KMS host, which will then activate Office 2010 automatically. This means you don't have to enter a product key on the client side. Windows 7 (volume editions) and Windows Server 2008 R2 are delivered with the KMS host that can activate Office 2010. The KMS host for Windows Vista and Windows Server 2008 can't be used for Office 2010 activation. Make sure that a DNS server that supports SRV records is available and that you have sufficient privileges. More information about KMS DNS configuration can be found here. KMS 1.1 can be downloaded and installed on Windows Server 2003 SP1 or later: 32-bit or 64-bit. After you install KMS 1.1, you have to update to KMS 1.2. You need at least Windows Server 2003 SP2 for that. For all Windows editions, you will need the KMS host license files for Office 2010, which are included in the Office 2010 KMS Host License Pack. Make sure your firewall allows outbound connections for the server where the KMS host runs. The KMS host will contact Microsoft's activation service. You also need the Office 2010 KMS host product key, which you can get at the Volume Licensing Service Center if you purchased Office 2010 licenses. You will also need the Office 2010 activation ID "bfe7a195-48f4f0b-a622-cf13c7d16864." The KMS host has to be activated with these commands: slmgr.vbs /ipk slmgr.vbs /ato You will need at least 5 Office 2010 installations before client activation starts (not 25, as for Windows Vista and Windows 7). After installation, Office 2010 will work normally without activation for a grace period of 25 days. After this, users will see notification dialogs whenever they start an Office application. After the 30th day, the title bar will turn red, reminding you that activation has failed. There is no Reduced Functionality Mode like with the retail editions of Office 2010. Thus users can still continue with their work. You can rearm Office 2010 5 times to extend this grace period to 180 days. Every KMS-activated Office 2010 has to renew its activation after 180 days. To verify which Office 2010 clients have been activated, you can use Microsoft's free Volume Activation Management Tool (VAMT). To activate your Office 2010, Visio 2010 or Project 2010 you can use both MAK or KMS volume activation methods. For midsize and large enterprise environments (250+ seats) KMS activation is the best suitable solution. If you currently using KMS for activating your operating systems (Windows 7, Windows Server 2008 R2) you are ready to activate Office 2010 as well by using the current Volume Activation solution. Review activation methods Office 2010 activation technologies provides two activation methods: Key Management Service (KMS) A server-client model in which a computer serves as the KMS host, which requires a KMS host key to be installed and activated. This establishes a local activation service in your environment. Office 2010 client computers connect to the local Office 2010 KMS host for activation. Multiple Activation Key (MAK) With a MAK key, Office 2010 client computers activate online by using the Microsoft hosted activation servers or by telephone. The kind of key installed determines the activation method. All Office 2010 volume license editions have the KMS client key pre-installed. You do not have to enter a product key if you are deploying KMS clients. If you want to use MAK activation, you have to enter the correct MAK key. Overview of Microsoft Office 2010 Volume Activation can be downloaded here. A combination of KMS and MAK can also be used. For example, Office 2010 running on desktops has the KMS client key installed, whereas Office 2010 running on portable computers has the MAK key installed. The model chosen depends on the size, network infrastructure, connectivity, and security requirements. You can choose to use only one or a combination of these activation models. Typically, the same activation method for a particular instance of Windows would be used for Office. For more information about how to decide which activation method to use, see the Windows Volume Activation Planning Guide (. Key Management Service (KMS) KMS is a server-client model in which a computer serves as the KMS host. KMS activation requires TCP/IP connectivity. By default, KMS hosts use DNS to publish the KMS service, and client computers connect to the KMS host for activation by using anonymous remote procedure calls (RPCs) through TCP port 1688. You can use the default settings, which require little or no administrative action, or manually configure KMS hosts and clients based on network configuration and security requirements. KMS activation steps The KMS host key for Office 2010 is not specific to a particular operating system. It is designed to be used on any of the operating systems supported as an Office 2010 KMS host, including both 32-bit and 64-bit editions: Windows Server 2003 or with any service packs Volume License editions of Windows 7 Windows Server 2008 R2 Resources: Mini KMS Activator Ultimate is a small, safe, simple and intuitive Windows & Office universal and offline activator based on KMS. KMS is a cyclic activation method. Its limited period of activation is 180 days, and you can renew it when it expires, so as to achieve the purpose of permanently using your Windows/Office products. It is able to automatically detect the version/edition of the operating system it is running on, and does automatic activation of Microsoft Windows 7/8.1/10 and Office 2010/2013/2016/2019/365 with one click, without any harm on system files. Besides, it also supports permanently activating Windows 10 by obtaining a Windows 10 digital license online. In summary, Mini KMS Activator Ultimate helps user activate all Windows and Office products in an easy way for a limited time (you can reactivate with one click). For example, compared to other activation tools, it will not be mistakenly reported as a virus, or bundled with malware. "KMS" (Key Management Service) is a technology used by Microsoft to activate software deployed in bulk (e.g., in a corporate environment). What KMSpico does is to replace the installed key with a volume license key, create an emulated instance of a KMS server on your machine (or in previous iterations of the software, search for KMS servers online) and force the products to activate against this KMS server. KMS activation only lasts for 180 days after which, it must be activated again. However, by using KMSpico, an activation service is created which runs KMSpico twice a day to reset this counter.
