
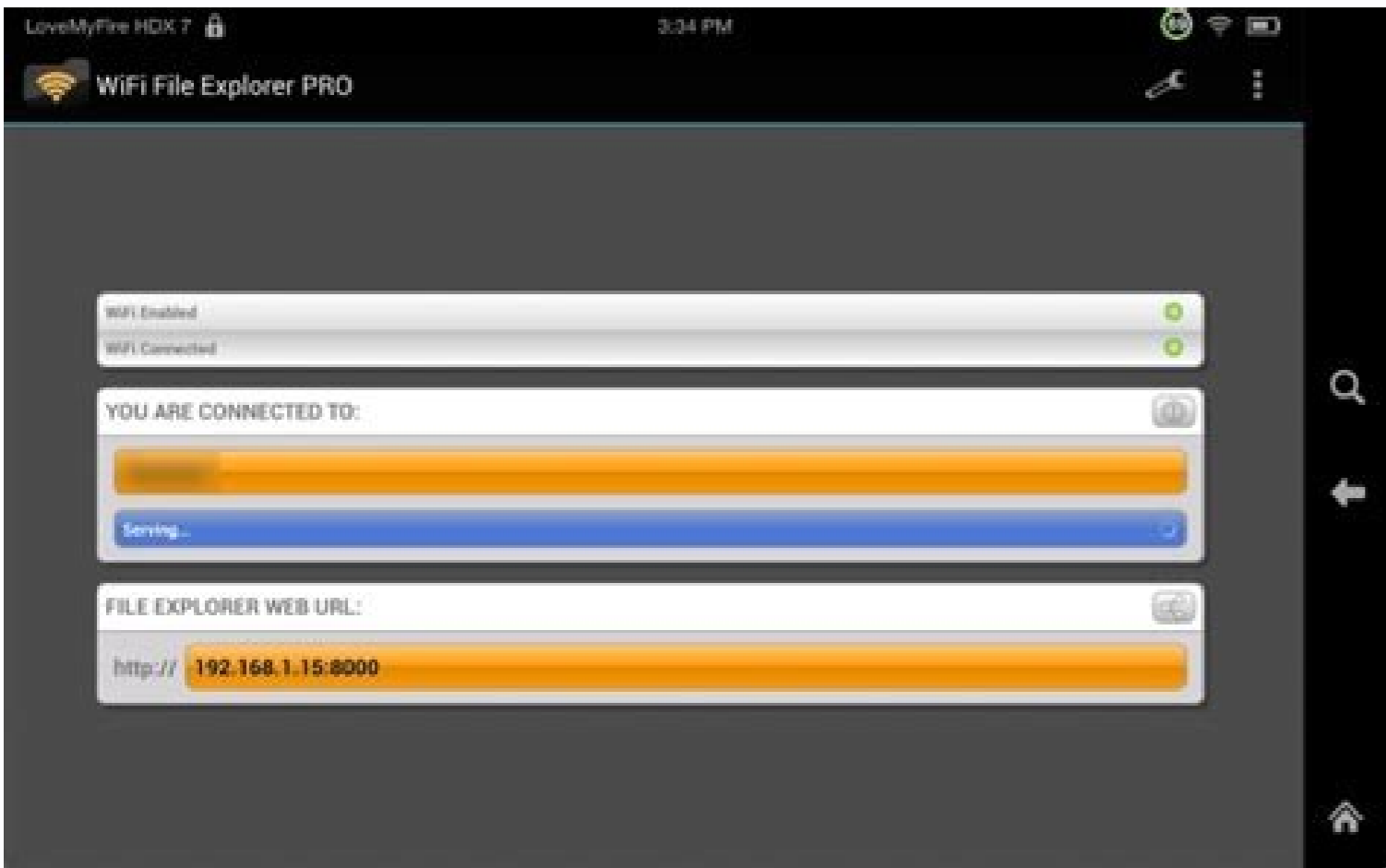
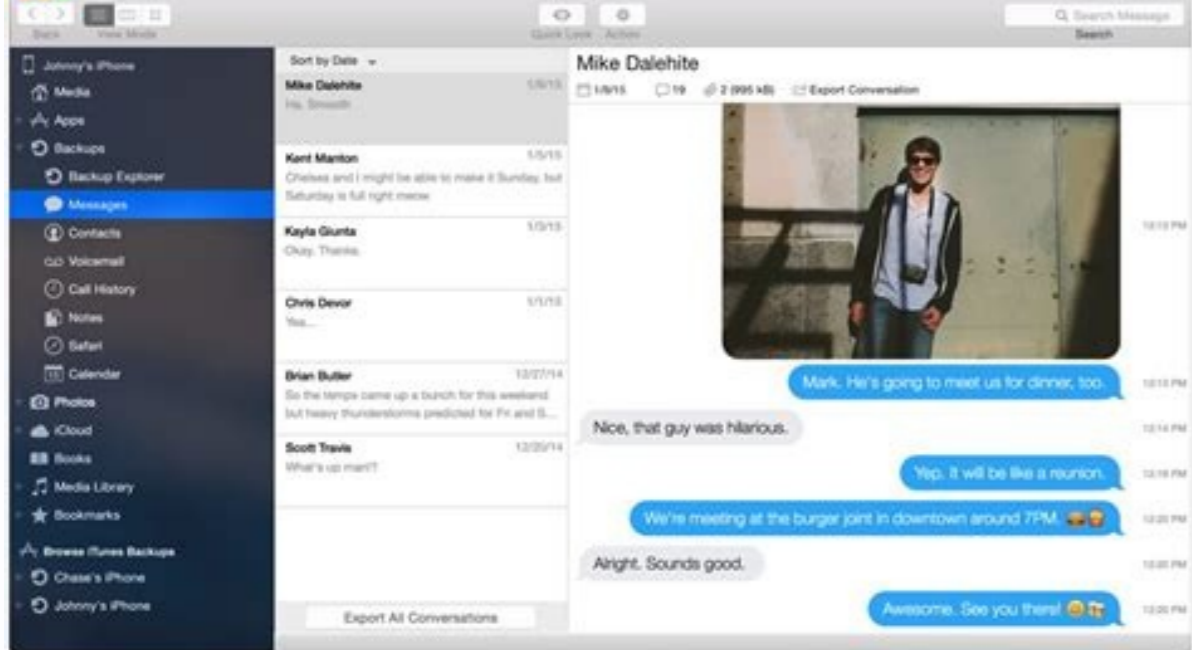

Make sure it's allowed on your phone too. Now go to Add Bluetooth or another device > Bluetooth and start scanning. After a short delay, your phone will appear. Select it, then click "Connect" on your computer and "Pair" on your phone to complete the process. To share a file via Bluetooth, go to Settings > Devices > Send or receive files via Bluetooth > Send files. Then select the file you want to share. On other platforms, the names of the menu items are different, but the procedure is the same. You have to link first, then you can share. Bluetooth is slower than some of the other methods we've mentioned and is best for small files and occasional use. When you need to transfer a lot of data to your phone on a regular basis, you can't beat Wi-Fi. With this option, you share one hard drive with all devices connected to the network. For most people, the above five methods are the best ways to transfer data from notebook to Android. Some are better for quickly sharing small files, and others are ideal for moving huge amounts of data. If you want to transfer large amounts of data, we recommend using a USB data transfer cable.
