Since its initial serialization from July to December 1991, the series has been reprinted in various formats and editions. The events of the series are driven by Thanos, a nihilist character created for Marvel by Starlin in 1973. When he started writing Starlin Silver Surfer in 1990, he and Lim began a new storyline with Thanos who has developed more than sixteen monthly issues and a limited spin-off series before concluding in the Infinity Gauntlet. However, after completing three issues, and part of the fourth, his busy schedule and dissatisfaction with the story led to him being replaced by Lim. At the beginning of The Infinity Gauntlet, the character Thanos collected And you're the gems of infinity and attached to her challenge glove. With their combined power, he becomes "like a god" and aims to conquer the affection of Mistress death, the living incarnation of death in the Marvel Universe. When Thanos uses the powers of him to instantly kill half of the Beings of the universe, Adam Warlock leads remaining heroes of the earth against him. After the Infinity Gauntlet was stolen from the evil nephew Thanos' Nebula, Thanos helps the remaining heroes defeat her. Warlock finally gets the glove of infinity and uses his power to cancel death and destruction. The series was a top seller for Marvel during the publication and was followed by two immediate sequel, the Infinity war (1992) and The Infinity Crusade (1993). The history events continued to be reference to other Marvel comics for decades. The Infinity Gauntlet has remained popular among fans, guaranteeing more editions reprinting and goods, with its themes and elements of the texture adapted in video games, cartoons and movies. History of the publication Background Jim Starlin introduced the first Thanos, the antagonist for the plot, in Iron Man # 55 in February 1973. After providing illustrative material for Captain Marvel # 24-25 (January 1973 and March 1973), Starlin Co-Generated # 26 (May 1973) with Mike Friedrich, which characterized Thanos (although in shadow) on a Marvel cover for the first time and marked the beginning of what was coined the "First Thanos War". [1] After collaborating with Friedrich for the # 27-28 (July and September 1973), then hired unique writing tasks for the rest of the cosmic saga sweeping from # 29-33 (November 1973 - July 1974). [2] Starlin completed a final number - # 34 (September 1974), placing the foundations for the possible death of the hero Mar-Vell -. Before leaving the title [3] in 1975, Starlin started writing and illustrating strange stories, where he made significant changes for Adam Warlock and developed the concept of the infinity gems. [1] He reintroduced Thanos earlier as Warlock is ally, then as his opponent in a texture known as the "Second War Thanos" which worked until 1977. [1] [4] Due to their closing publications of the The two Thanos wars are sometimes considered as a plot. [2] Both are considered "cosmic" stories and led to Starlin to be known as a "cosmic" writer. [1] [5] Starlin left his regular work for Marvel after concluding the second War Thanos, [6], but from time to time postponed for projects soon as the death of Captain Marvel Graphic Novel and the creator's work of property, like the themed cosmic dreadstar through 1980. [7] He also made a high profile job for DC Comics, such as Batman and Cosmic Odyssey. [5] In an interview of 1990, Starlin described as the only writer who was allowed to "play" with Thanos, [8], although other authors had written some tie-in chapters of the first Thanos war . [9] [10] George PÁ Á © Rez is a popular artist known to draw comic books with large casts. It came to the fore in 1970 while working on The Avengers of Marvel before leaving the company to work for the DC on the comic like New Teen Titans, crisis on endless lands, and Wonder Woman. [12] Serious Writer Development Jim Starlin in 2008 in 1988, Steve Englehart wrote Silver Surfer and one of him involved the gems of infinity and death mistress.
